Remove spent flowers and stalks and any dead foliage from agapanthus and other spring/summer flowering perennials.

Trim or pinch back leggy annuals and perennials such as alyssum, begonias, coleus, chrysanthemums, basil, and Mexican bush sage to help them bush out with more fullness.

Avoid fertilizing St. Augustine grass until early September to reduce outbreaks of the fungal disease "gray leaf spot" that causes diamond-shaped gray/



Bloom Where You are Planted

Grass blades may roll or fold. Water at the first signs of drought. (Some plants may wilt in the noon sun without being dry, but wilting in the early morning or evening signals a need for water.)

Keep plants mulched to preserve the moisture in the ground and moderate the rate of temperature changes in the soil in the summer heat (as well as helping to prevent weeds and making the beds more attractive, etc.).
