#### ARTICLE I.

The corporation is a non-profit corporation, And mall have all of the powers specified in the Texas Non-Profit Corporation of.

#### AMTICLE III.

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The purpose or purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

1. 2. To arrange for, provide and pay for the furnishing to the applicable subdivisions of the following: the cleaning and maintenance of streets, sidewalks, paths, parks, parkways, esplanades and vacant lots; providing street lighting and fogging for insect control; planting and caring for and watering transplanted trees and shrubbery at entrances, in osplanades and on vacantalots; providing back door garbage and rubbish pickup, encouraging compliance with and enforcement of all covenants and restrictions in the applicable subdivisions; owning, leasing, providing, maintaining and operating recreational facilities, including hat not limited to, swimming pools, club houses and private park areas; and doing any other thing necessary or desirable in the opinion of the Trustees of this corporation to keep the property of the applicable subdivisions heat and in good order or which the Trustees consider of general benefit to the owners or occupants of lots in the applicable subdivisions; and to do any and all other acts in connection with all of the above purposes.

### ARTICLE V.

The street address of the imitial registered office of the corporation is 13202 Memorial Drive, Mouston, Texas, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is E. B. Ramsey.

#### ARTICLE VIII.

The initial Trustees shall serve until January 1, 1970. In case of the resignation, death or incapacity to serve of any of said initial Trustees prior to said time, the two remaining a Trustees may appoint a Substitute Trustee to serve the remainder of said period. In the case of the resignation, death or incapacity to serve of more than one of said initial Trustees, then the remaining Trustee may appoint Substitute Trustees to serve the remainder of the said period. The judgment of the Trustees, whether the Trustees are the initial Trustees or Substitute Trustees, in the expenditure of funds of this corporation shall be final and conclusive, so long as such judgment is exercised in good faith. The by-Laws of this corporation shall be adopted by the initial Board of Trustees and shall thereafter be amended or altered by a majority vote of the members.

After January 1, 1970, the following shall apply to the corporation:

- a. The members of this corporation shall be the owners of the lots in the applicable subdivisions.
- b. Each lot in the applicable subdivisions shall be entitled to one (1) vote at any maeting of the members.
- c. The affairs of this corporation shall be run by three (3) Trustees, who shall be either (1) a residential owner occupant of a lot in an applicable subdivision, or (2) an officer of a corporation, partner in a extuerable or individual owning and developing one or not lots in the applicable hubdivisions; and unid Trustees shall be elected

at an annual meeting of the members or at a special meeting of the members called for much purposes.

- d. The annual meeting of the members shall be at 8:00 p.m. on January 2nd of each year commencing in 1970, and shall be held at a place in mouston, Texas. The Trustees shall mail notices of the place of the annual meeting to the members at least fifteen (15) days but not more than fifty (50) days prior to the date of said meeting.
- e. Trustees shall be elected for a term of one (1)
  year, but they can be removed prior to that time at a special meeting of the members by a majority vote of the members
  present, provided a quorum is present.
  - f. In order to constitute a quorum at any meeting at least ten (10%) per cent of the members of this corporation must be present or represented by proxy.
  - g. Special meetings may be called by any two of the Trustees or by ten (10%) per cent of the members of the corporation; and written or printed notices stating the place, date, hour and purpose for which the meeting is called shall be delivered not less than fifteen (15) days nor more than fifty (50) days before the date of the meeting by mail or by or at the direction of the person or persons calling the meeting to each member untitled to vote at such meeting.
